# **DIRECTIONS**

### MAL #1: Home of Brenda Rech

Coming from the city:

Drive North down McPhillips to Leila. Turn West on Leila and continue until you reach Pipeline Road (second set of lights). Turn North on Pipeline. Continue North until you see a house with a LARGE green roof on your right. If you come to the Perimeter, you have gone too far.

Coming from the Perimeter: Drive on the North Perimeter until you reach Pipeline Road (Lights) Turn South on Pipeline (towards the city) Drive about a mile until you see a house with a LARGE green roof on your left. If you reach Leila you have gone too far.

# Notice to Exhibitors:

Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they have read and understood all information within this premium list, including but not limited to the following:

- The Manitoba Agility League is a fun-match style league, designed to encourage learning, cooperation and teamwork.
- MAL will follow the rules and regulations of the Agility Association of Canada (AAC); check out http://www.aac.ca
- Dogs MUST BE at least 18 months of age to enter. It is open to all dogs, purebred or mixed breed, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance (coordinators and judges' discretion)
- Scorekeeping rules will be modified for MAL
- Dogs MUST be able to perform ALL obstacles in a safe manner
- Number of dogs per team and level of dogs will be set <u>AFTER CLOSING</u>; changes to teams may incur depending on the number of entrants to ensure fairness
- Handlers should attend <u>ALL 3 MATCHES</u> and all team members will participate in two runs per match (Standard & Game)
- The top 3 runs from each team will be used for scoring (subject to change depending on number of dogs per team)
- Scores will be accumulated and combined from all 3 matches
- Each team will be required to volunteer at one match. This includes course building, ring crew, etc.
- Dogs exhibiting ANY signs of aggression anywhere on the site (to people or other dogs) will be dismissed
- MAL has the right to refuse entry to any dog/handler
- Dogs can ONLY be off-leash in the ring. Please ensure that your dog is under control at all times
- All dogs must be crated, penned or leashed when not in the ring, and may not be tied to any obstacles, permanent or temporary anywhere on the grounds. Dogs are not to be left unattended unless appropriately crated. Please take responsibility for your dog and children. Any handler whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behaviour may be asked to leave the event site. There will be no refunds given if a handler or dog is dismissed from MAL for any reason
- Leads, flat collars without tags, toys and food will be permitted on course. Please be considerate of other dogs in the ring and use only NON CRUMBLING, easy to swallow treats. Please do not play with toys near the ring, particularly when other dogs are running
- Please clean up after your dog and yourself; all garbage should be picked up and thrown away. Garbage cans and recycle bins will be set up on site.
- Kennelling will be outdoors. MAL is not responsible for any belongings left unattended.
- Please follow all signs regarding parking and setting up
- All obstacles have been inspected and meet MAL specifications
- After the closing date, refunds will only be given if the dog is injured sufficiently to prevent them from running. MAL coordinators must be informed prior to May 30, 2014 at 6pm and a certificate from a veterinarian must be provided
- No entry fee will be refunded if the match or matches cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizers. All attempts to reschedule the event will be made.
- Bitches in season may not be run; no refunds will be given
- All entries will be confirmed via email where an email address is supplied; please ensure it is valid and legible
- Food and drinking water will not be available so please come prepared for yourself and your canine friend. A wading pool will be available for dogs. Bring your own shade and chair.
- PLEASE NOTE: Abuse, in any form of volunteers, other handlers, dogs or the judges will NOT be tolerated

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry by the Manitoba Agility League (MAL) and Backyard Agility Dogs (the "**Organizing Club**") and the opportunity to have the Dog participate, compete in and/or be judged at this event, I, the undersigned, agree as follows:

(the "**Dog**") (the "**Dog**")

- 1) I certify that I am the actual owner of the Dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner of the Dog and that the Dog is not a hazard to persons, property or other dogs.
- 2) I agree that the Organizing Club for the Event may refuse my entry for any reason that it deems to be sufficient.
- 3) I understand and acknowledge that participated in the Event carries certain risks, including, but not limited to injuries (including serious injuries and death) to myself, the Dog, another dog under my control or persons attending as my guests (my "Related Parties"), damage to property and other losses. I waive any and all claims that I have or may have in the future against, and release from all liability and agree not to sue MAL, the Organizing Club or any of the co-ordinators, committees, representatives, employees, volunteers or agents of either MAL or the Organizing Club (the "Personnel") for any injury, death, property damage or other loss that I or my Related Parties sustain due to any cause whatsoever, including negligence, breach of contract, breach of duty, statutory or otherwise, or mistakes or errors of judgement of any kind.
- 4) I assume full responsibility for the conduct of myself and my Related Parties during the entirety of the Event. I agree to indemnify and save harmless MAL, the Organizing Club and the Personnel from and against any and all claims that may be made against them or costs, fees, expenses or liability (including, without limitation, lawyers' fees on a solicitor and own client basis) incurred by MAL, the Organizing Club or the Personnel that may arise due to:
  - (a) Any act or omission of myself, my Related Parties or any party for whom I am liable at law; or

- 5) I have read, and do understand the rules of competition and the additional rules (if any) appearing in the trial schedule for the Event, as well as the policies of MAL pertaining to discipline (collectively, the "**Rules**"). I agree to abide by the Rules and to conduct myself and the Dog in accordance with the Rules. I understand that myself and/or the Dog may be subject to disciplinary procedures or sanctions for breach of the Rules and agree to respect and be bound by any disciplinary decision made by MAL.
- 6) I understand that MAL and/or the Organizing Club may, in the course of administering the Event or conducting its activities generally, collect, use or disclose my personal information and that any personal information collected, used or disclosed by MAL and/or the Organizing Club will be treated in accordance with MAL policy and applicable privacy and personal information laws.
